WHERE DO I FIND OUT ABOUT GAME TIMES?

Allocation of all games for all teams is under the control of the GBJRL – not us! The GBJRL publish information on their website, which then gets uploaded to our website under the Fixtures tab, and also on the FB page. Details available there in advance may not be correct or updated if game details are changed during the week. Please check back at our website on Friday's. Thursday night is the latest time for a Club to forward any forfeits etc.

Changes will be made where necessary and your team manager/coach informed immediately.

TEAM MANAGER

Your Team Manager should be your first point of contact for all enquiries & queries that you may have. Our Team Managers are knowledgeable about the club and willing to help you.

All information from the club is forwarded to your team manager in the first instance to pass on to players/families so please ensure you familiarise yourself with your manager and keep your details up to date.

WET WEATHER INFORMATION

The decision on field closures for training nights is at the discretion of the President. Team Managers will be advised as soon as a decision is made. A Notice will also be made to the FB page and the website.

Coaches have the ability to cancel training independently from the club however they are responsible for contacting players directly.

The decision to cancel game days is at the discretion of each Club – once the Secretary is advised from the GBJRL office then she will advise your team manager.

Please always assume the game is to go ahead until you hear from your manager.

Most clubs play will play in the rain unless their grounds are closed due to flooding.

COMPLAINTS

All complaints, no matter what the issue, need to be submitted in writing. You will be advised by your Team Manager to put your complaint into letter or email format (include any written documentation from any other concerned parties) and forward it to the club. The complaint will be assessed and if further action is warranted a covering letter with team documentation will be forwarded to the GBJRL and / or relevant department. The GBJRL if receiving a letter of complaint directly from an individual party will return the letter and advise the individual to contact their club



NORTHS JUNIORS PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Avoid unnecessary confrontation and allow match officials to control the game rather than retaliate to foul play or abuse. Report any racial abuse to your captain to bring to the attention of the referee.
2. Treat team mates, opposition & officials as you would want to be treated. Norths Juniors do not tolerate verbal, physical or racial abuse of players, officials or spectators at any time.
3. Never, under any circumstances enter the field of play to join in a fight. Reserves from the bench and players who have been dismissed or sin-binned, who unlawfully enter the field of play will face maximum penalties under this code and junior league rules including automatic loss of competition points.
4. Always play the game within the rules of rugby league and always show good sportsmanship. Be sure to shake hands with opposition after every match win, lose or draw.
5. Remember, while you are representing Norths Juniors on or off the field you should never act in a way that would bring yourself, the game of the Club into disrepute.
6. Most officials, coaches, managers and referees give their time voluntarily so you can play for Norths Juniors. Treat these people with respect.

By signing the Registration form allowing your child to represent Norths Juniors Rugby League Football Club Inc., you agree to abide by all rules of the Queensland Rugby League and GBJRL.
